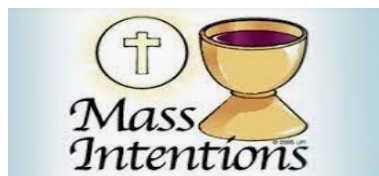

gathered round him he moved to
Cork at the mouth of the Lee
where he founded a monastery
which became a famous centre of
learning .
